Late Arrival

If your visa is delayed, you may arrive until the end of October.



Later arrivals will not be accepted because too many lectures, courses, and possibly even examinations will have been missed.

In this case, you will have to postpone the start of your studies by one year. This means:

- Cancellation of current enrollment, refund of semester contribution, re-application
- It is not necessary to re-apply via uni-assist
- You can re-apply easily via the TUD application portal, starting April 1, 2025 (!)
- IO will forward your re-application for the winter semester 2025 to the faculty for a new aptitude assessment
- Information regarding the re-application process under the heading "Repeat Application"









For white trains with red stripes as well as for blue trains you need a DIFFERENT ticket


