## Attachment to the supervision agreement Supplementary agreement for a doctorate in cooperation with the private sector (industry-sponsored doctorate)

#### – Preamble –

Within the framework of a doctorate in cooperation with businesses at TU Dresden, early-career researchers qualify for employment in academia and the private sector. The doctorate constitutes an independent achievement in research that is accompanied and supervised by experienced researchers. TU Dresden holds the responsibility for the doctorate proceedings. The terms of the proceedings are stipulated in the current doctorate regulations of the respective Faculty. As for doctorates in cooperation with businesses, TU Dresden, the participating company, and the doctoral candidate bear collective responsibility for the doctorate.

The following agreement supplements the supervision agreement and ensures a clearly defined scope of action for all parties involved. Furthermore, this attachment should serve as a guideline for the responsible Faculty or for the Doctoral Board (Promotionsausschuss) of the Faculty, which decides on the admission of the doctoral candidate.

### 3. Provisions for publication and utilisation

- As the author of the dissertation, the doctoral candidate is entitled to the intellectual property rights for his
  or her dissertation. All data, sources and methods, which the dissertation is based on, must be accessible and
  verifiable.
- 2. The doctoral candidate and the primary supervisor are committed to the Statutes for Ensuring Good Scientific Practice, Avoiding Scientific Misconduct, and Handling Violations of TU Dresden and regulations for dealing with scientific misconduct. The principles are known to the mentor and are to be respected by the company.
- 3. The **publication of the dissertation** as scientific qualification work is stipulated by examination proceedings and must take place within the period specified in the respective doctoral regulations<sup>3</sup>.
- 4. All participants agree that the presentation and discussion of (interim) results to an expert audience is a fundamental part of scientific work. Therefore, research results should be presented in a suitable form (articles in scientific journals and conference publications with quality assurance, patents) before completing the dissertation. In all publications produced in the course of the dissertation, the doctoral candidate must always mention his:her affiliation to TU Dresden.

**Confidentiality** due to possible commercial use can only take place over a short, predetermined period of time. An agreement was reached on this:
