**What is the legal basis for the processing of personal data?**

The legal basis for processing the data for the aforementioned purposes is Art. 6 (1) lit. b DSGVO.

**What personal data is processed and how, how long is it stored and is it transmitted to third parties?**

Only the personal data and attached documents specified in the application form will be processed for the purpose of using and implementing the program. The data or documents will be deleted once the purpose no longer applies, but no later than 12 months after the end of the funding. Data required for proper proof of the use of funds at the TU Dresden are stored for a period of 10 years due to budgetary regulations.

Unless otherwise stipulated by law or you have expressly consented in individual cases, no personal data will be transferred to third parties.

**What are the basic rights of data subjects?**

To exercise the rights, a communication in text form (letter or e-mail) to the data controller is sufficient.

You have the right to request information about the data processed about you and the possible recipients of this data at any time. In addition, you can request the correction, deletion and restriction of data processing.
