<b>Application Procedure</b>	<p>Application documents should be sent to the Directorate for Internationalization of Education Universitas Indonesia. The office will deliver the application to the related faculty where the application will be reviewed. Upon approval from the faculty, we will issue admission packets to students. We will serve as their point of contact during their stay once students arrive at the university.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Student should make contact with the office at their university or host to manage exchange program.</li><li>• Student must seek advice and approval from home university to join our exchange program.</li><li>• Nominated student must complete the UI Student Exchange application form.</li><li>• Student must submit the complete application form and supporting documents to the Directorate for Internationalization of Education Universitas Indonesia.</li><li>• Following receipt of students' application, we will seek approval for the requested study program from relevant faculty. Once it has been approved by the related faculty, an acceptance letter will be issued to the student.</li></ul>

#### PRACTICAL

<b>Visa Requirement</b>	<p>All international students must have a valid visa to enter Indonesia. We suggest student to get the student visa. But, the process to obtain this immigration document will take about 60 to 90 days, because student should get a study permit (from the Ministry of Research, Technology &amp; Higher Education in Indonesia) and telex visa (from the Directorate General of Immigration-Jakarta).</p> <p><b>Please be advised that these immigration process can only be started after getting the letter of acceptance.</b></p>
<b>Arrival</b>	<p>Exchange students are expected to arrive immediately before each Semester starts.</p> <p>Semester 1: Early of August Semester 2: End of January</p>
<b>Insurance</b>	<p>International students should have International medical insurance valid for their entire study at Universitas Indonesia.</p>
<b>Accommodation</b>	<p>As the number of rooms available in our university dormitory are very limited, we suggest students to find off-campus housing. Student can request for housing at their own expenses. Unless otherwise stated. The estimated fee for off-campus housing, living cost, meals, etc. can be found in this fact sheet information.</p>
